Roles and Responsibilities: The selected trainers will be responsible for:

- Conducting 2 days' training sessions for Youth-Led Organizations (YLOs) across the 8 divisions of Bangladesh.
- Delivering interactive and participatory sessions to YLOs on:
 - o Gender Stereotypes and Girls' and Women's Rights
 - o Safeguarding and Digital Safety
 - o Media Literacy, Influencing, Lobbying, and Advocacy
- Delivering interactive session and participatory sessions to Content Creators across the 8 divisions on:
 - o Gender Stereotypes and Girls' and Women's Rights
 - o Safeguarding and Digital Safety
- Adapting training modules to local contexts and participant needs.
- Providing feedback and recommendations to improve training effectiveness.
- Supporting YLOs in developing their own guidelines on the above topics.

Special Notes:

- The required training modules and Trainers' Guide on the above mentioned topics will be provided.
- Training of Trainers (ToT) will be provided.

Qualifications and Experience:

- Proven experience in conducting training on relevant topics such as gender equality, youth empowerment, media literacy, advocacy, and safeguarding.
- Strong understanding of gender stereotypes, digital safety, and media literacy.







- Ability to engage diverse youth audiences and facilitate interactive sessions.
- Experience in developing educational materials and delivering training in both urban and rural settings.
- Strong communication skills in both Bangla and English.
- Masters in any relevant field.
