The "**Shomotay Tarunno: Youth for Equality**" initiative represents a collaborative synergy between the **JAAGO Foundation Trust** and **Plan International Bangladesh**, underwritten by the **Embassy of the Kingdom of the Netherlands (EKN)**. This multifaceted project is predicated on the mobilization of **Youth Led Organizations (YLOs)** to serve as the primary catalysts for socio-legal transformation within the Bangladeshi context.

In alignment with the core values of the "**Shomotay Tarunno: Youth for Equality**" project, we are seeking **exclusively female trainers** to spearhead the capacitation of Youth Led Organizations (YLOs). This strategic decision ensures that the mentorship provided is rooted in lived experience and gender-responsive leadership, fostering a secure and empowering environment for youth advocates across eight divisions of Bangladesh.

Position: Trainers (only female) for Capacity Building of Youth Led Organizations on Combating Gender Stereotypes and Media Literacy and Advocacy.

Roles and Responsibilities: The selected trainers will be responsible for:

- Conducting training sessions for Youth-Led Organizations (YLOs) across the 8 divisions of Bangladesh.
- Delivering interactive and participatory sessions on:
 - Gender Stereotypes and Girls' and Women's rights
 - Safeguarding and Digital Safety
 - Media Literacy, Influencing, Advocacy and Lobbying
 - Effective Facilitation
- Joining the refreshers training of the trainers, organised by JAAGO Foundation Trust
- Adapting training modules to local contexts and participant needs.
- Providing feedback and recommendations to improve training.
- Supporting YLOs in developing their own guidelines on the above topics.

Qualifications and Experience:

- Proven experience in conducting training on relevant topics such as gender equality, youth empowerment, media literacy, advocacy, and safeguarding.
- Strong understanding of gender stereotypes, digital safety, and media literacy.
- Ability to engage diverse youth audiences and facilitate interactive sessions.
- Experience in developing educational materials and delivering training in both urban and rural settings.
- Strong communication skills in both Bangla and English.
- University lecturers/faculty members are encouraged to apply.
